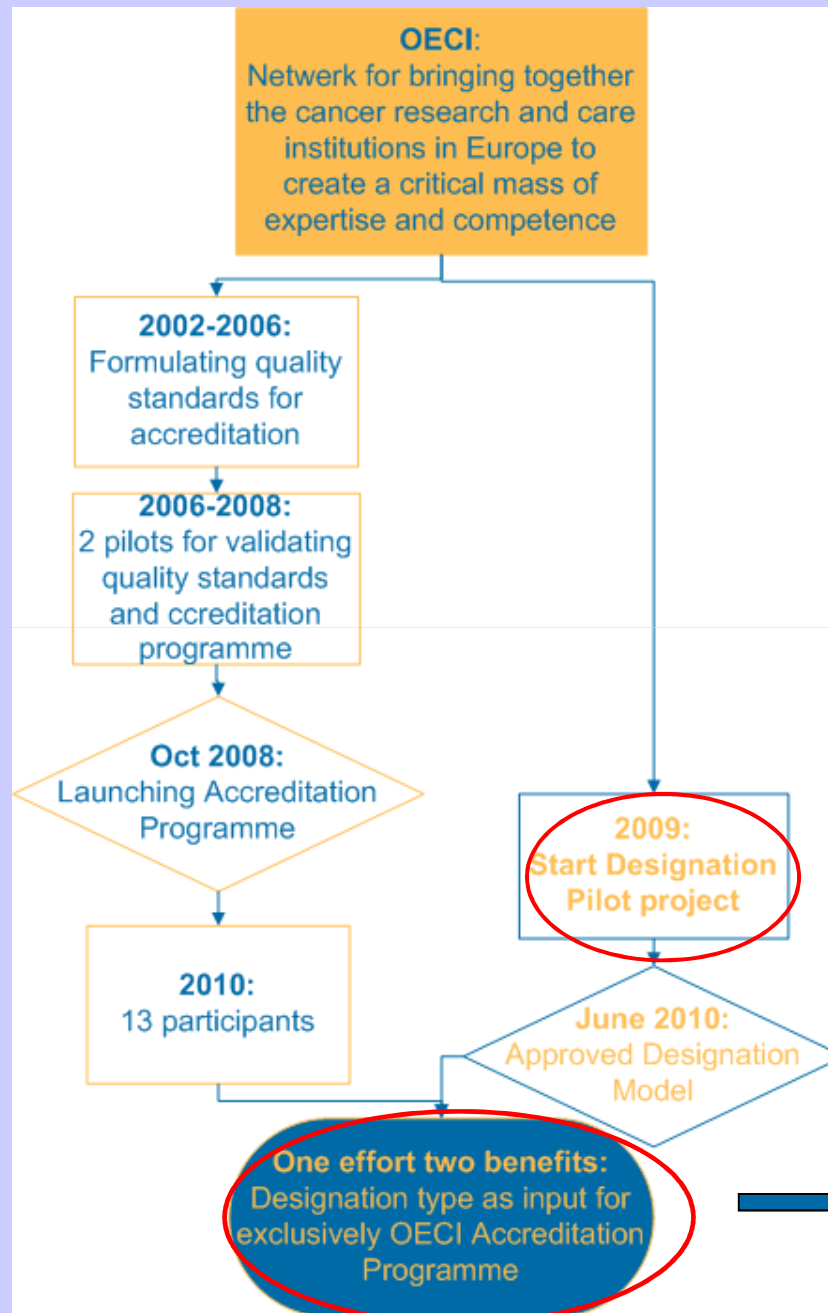

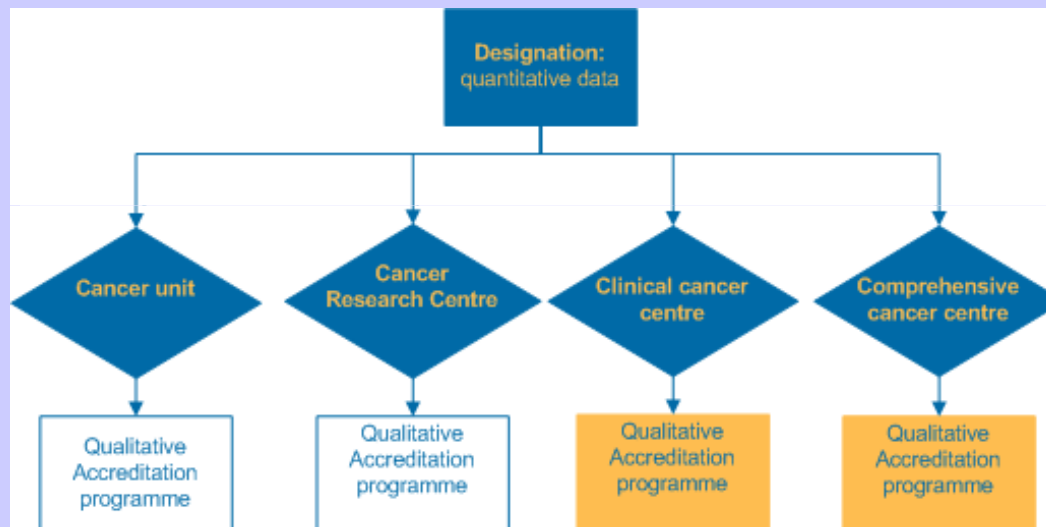

- Exclusive relation OECI accreditation programme

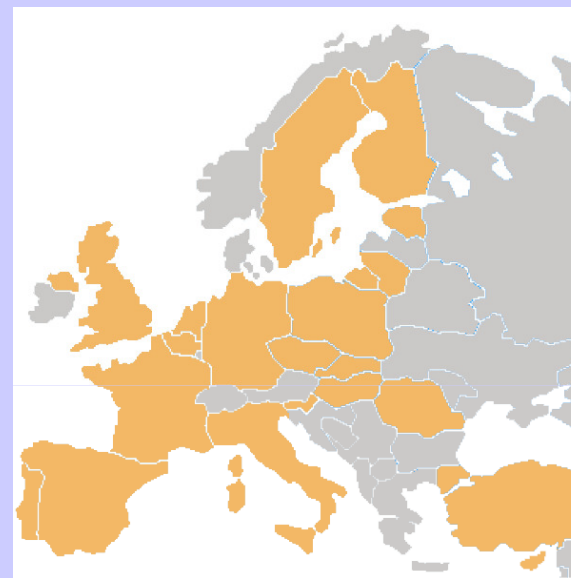

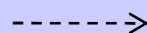

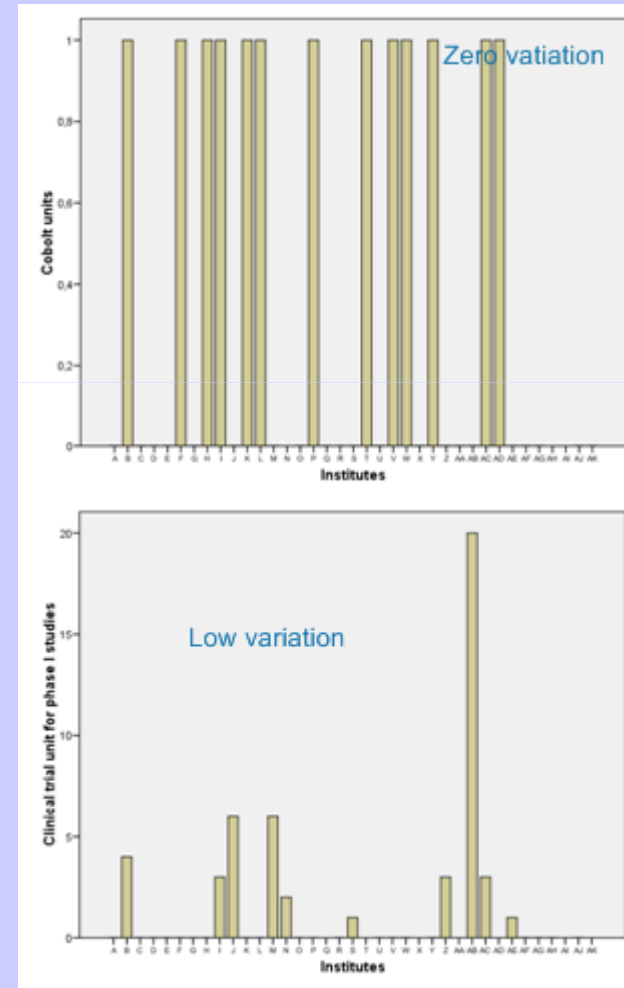

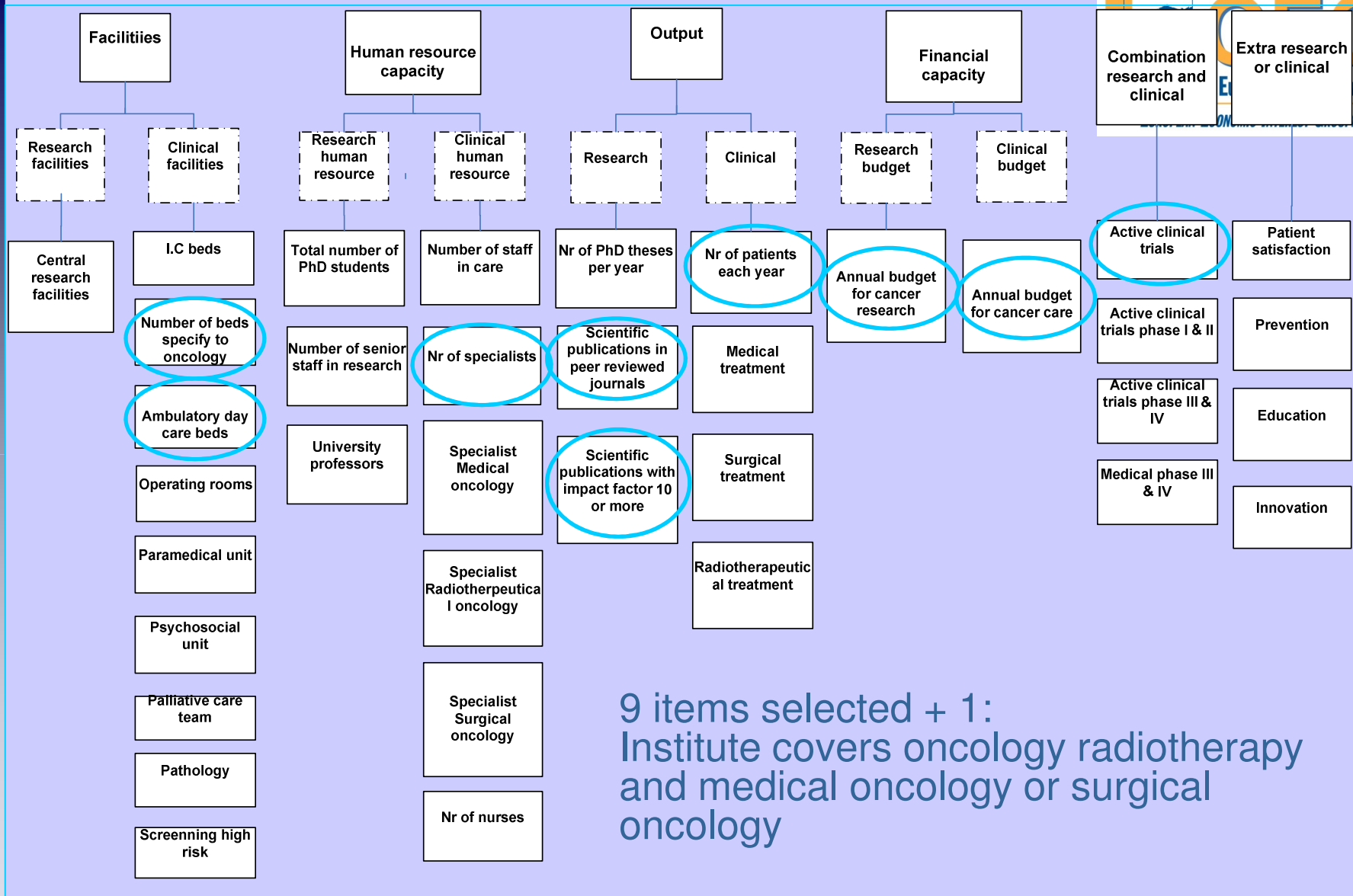

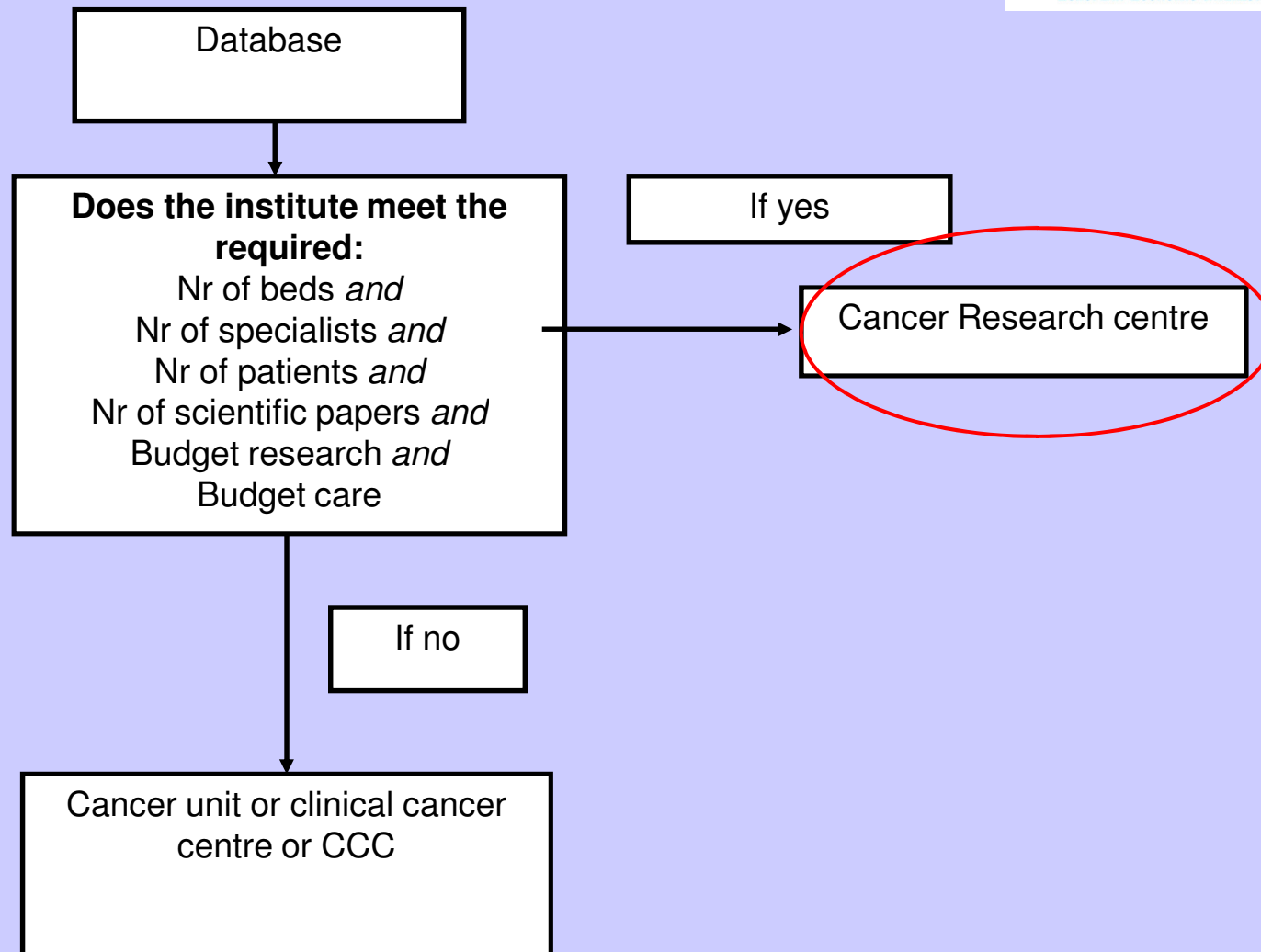

- Designation approved OECI Board on General Assembly, June 2010

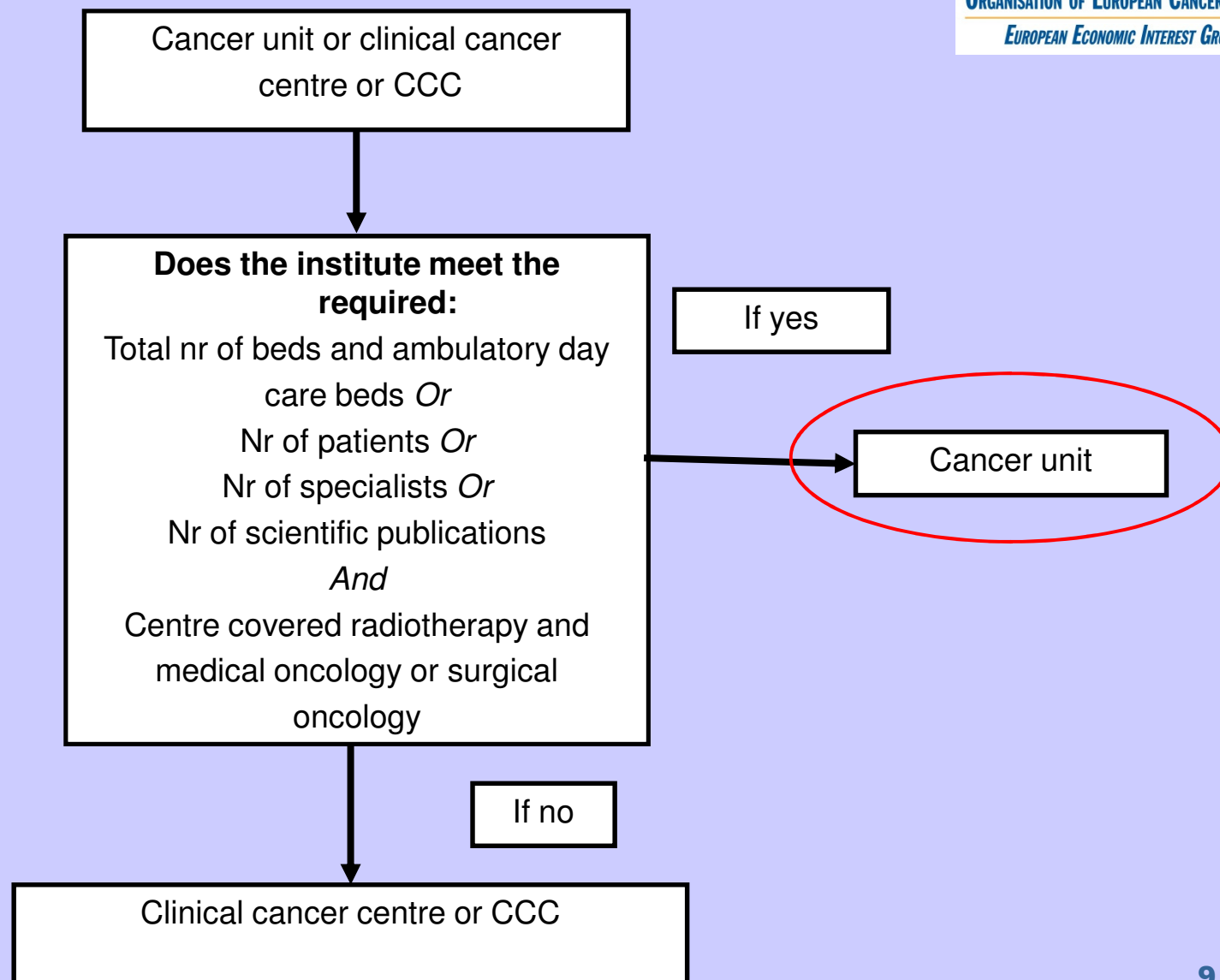

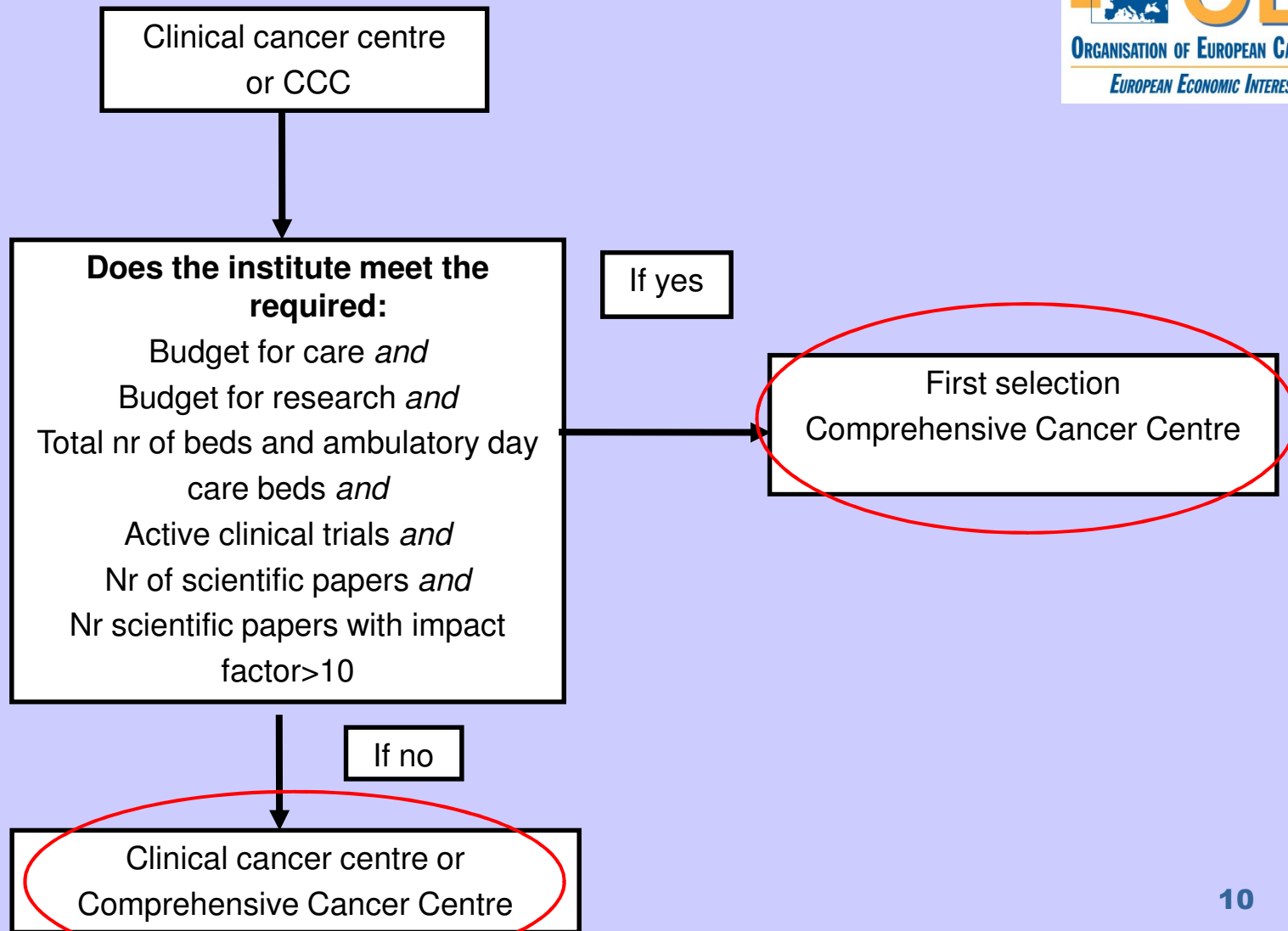
Decision tree: Step 1



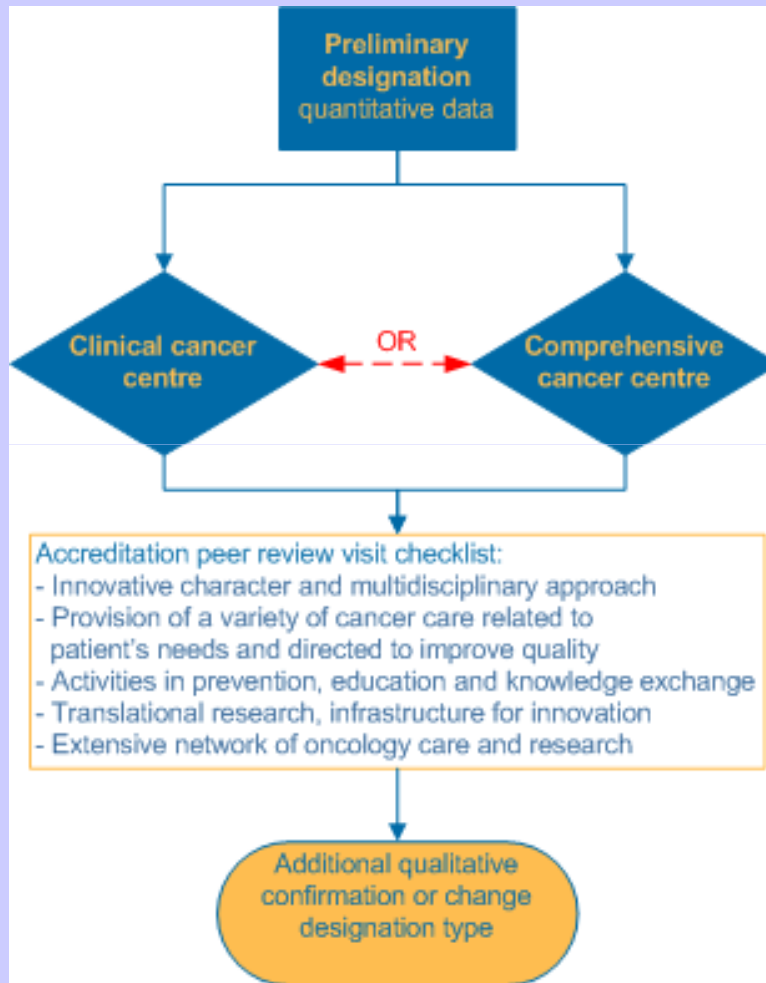
Decision tree: Step 2

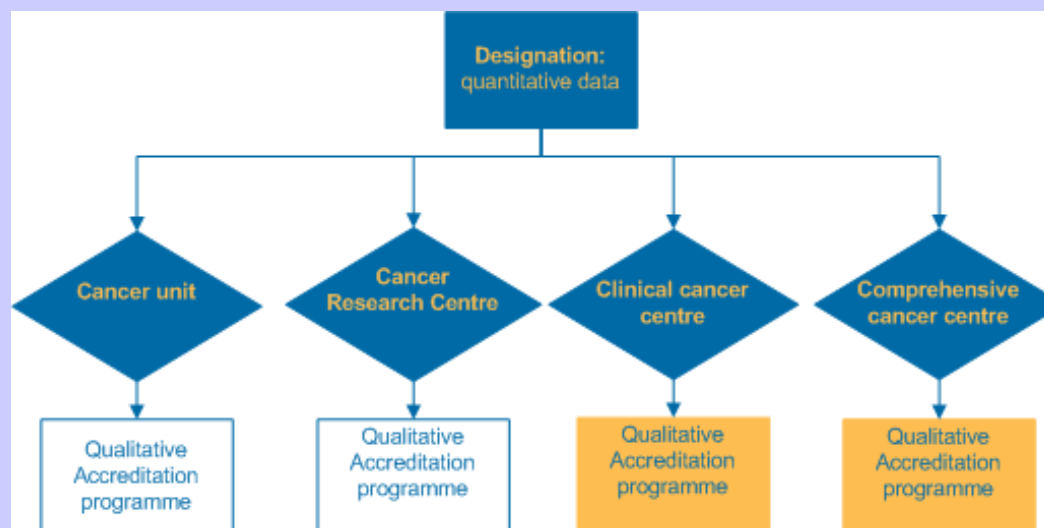

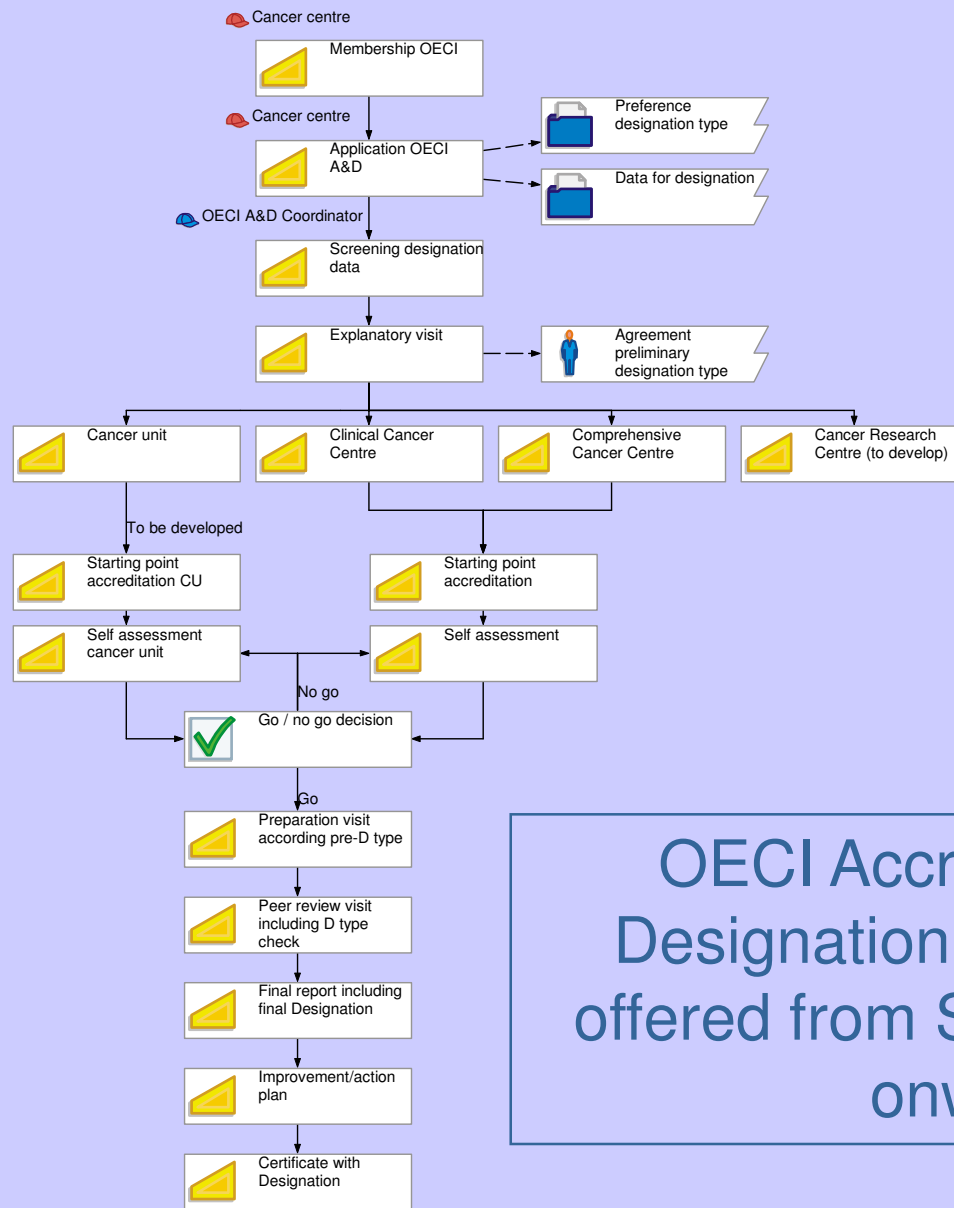

Integrated process



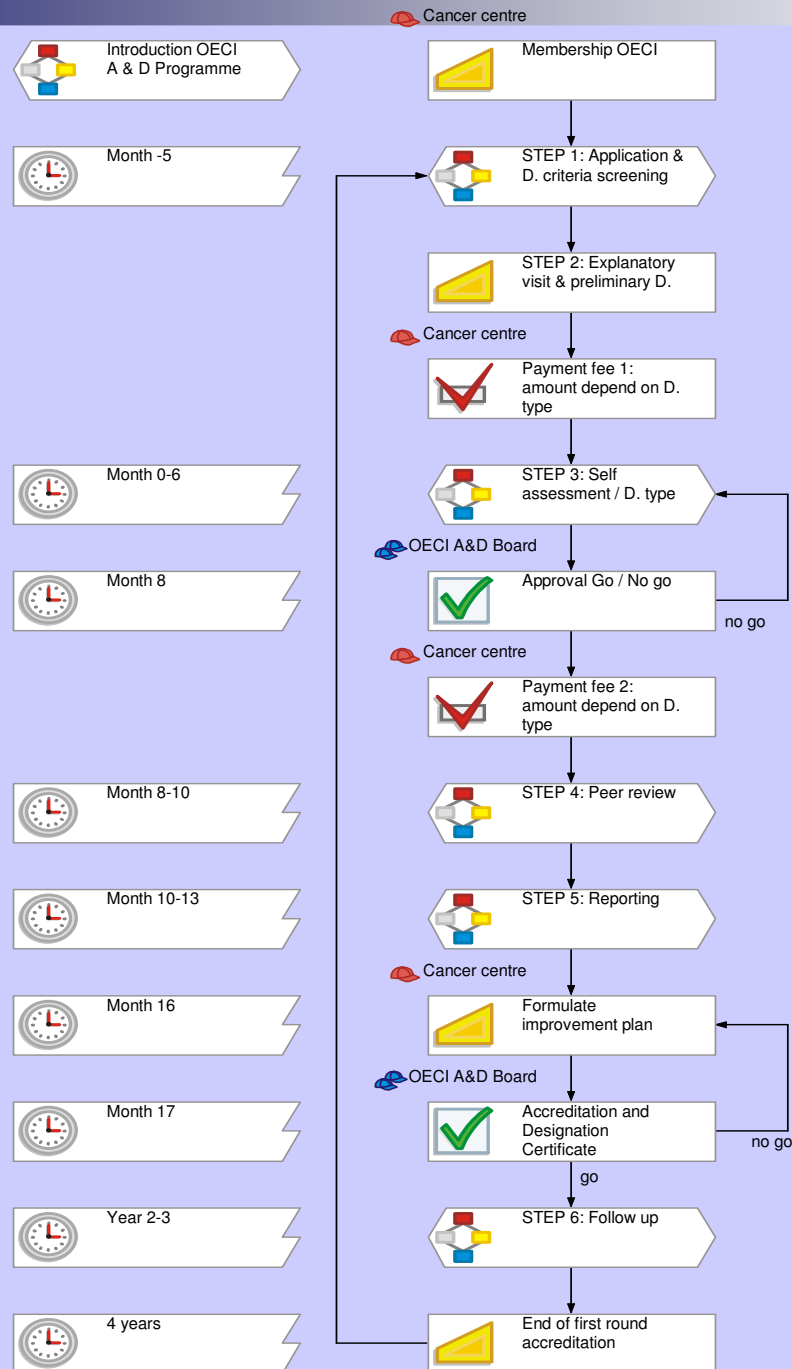
OECI Accreditation and Designation Programme is offered from September 2010 onwards

Explanation process



- Sign on the website to fill out application form,
 - Form includes questions for data for designation screening,
- Application will be analyzed by OECI A&D Board for approval,
- After approval the preliminary designation results will be explained and discussed during explanatory visit on site of the institute, as well as the procedures of the specialized accreditation,
- Preliminary designation results is starting point for specialized accreditation programme,
- Continue with next sheet: timelines.

Explanation timeline



- Step 1: application and designation screening
- Step 2: explanatory visit on site of the institute to explain the programme and to discuss the preliminary designation results
 - Payment order stage 1 programme fee: amount depends on designation type,
- Step 3: Selfassessment (SA) by cancer institute including delivering requested proof documents (6 months). Type of SA depends on designation type,
 - After SA the A&D Committee analyzes the SA results and proposes a go/no go to the A&D Board. Go/no go decision in month 8,
 - If Go: payment order stage 2, depending on designation type,
- Step 4: After the Go it takes 2 months to preparing the peer review visit by the auditors team. In month 10: During the peer review visit on site of the institute, the designation screening results and additional requirements for comprehensiveness are checked,

- Explanation continues on the next sheet...

- Step 5: The institute will get the opportunity to give feedback on the draft peer review draft report including the proposal for the definitive designation type
 - The A&D Committee analyzes the draft report and proposes the final report to the A&D Board for final approval,
- The institute writes an improvement action plan with regard to the opportunities stated in the final report, containing goals, actions and improvement planning,
- The improvement action plan will be analyzed by the A&D Committee, they proposes a final decision about the plan to the A&D Board,
- The A&D Board decides about the final certificate approval,
- Step 6: After one year the centre will have a follow-up about the goals and actions for the improvements.
